# Step 1 Ordinary World

Candles are lit during a Jewish Sabbath A candle goes out Smoke becomes the smoke of a train 1:43
Great example of opening image We will come back to this later

Text on the screen tells us that Jews are being transported to Krakow

Bunch of administrative stuff put down on a table

Bunch of Jews names typed up on a screen

Contrast
We go to Oscar's world
Bunch of nice suits
Ties
Cufflinks
This is a man who lives well
3:50

Plenty of money in a drawer

Puts on a Nazi badge But we don't see his face

Restaurant

He comes up to the maitre-d who takes money from his pocket

4:44

He sits in a chair in the restaurant smoking He's watching all the Nazi officers

A table is reserved
He orders drinks for the Nazis
Who shall I say they are from
From me
From the gentleman
Do we know him?
Find out who he is

Intrigue as to who he is Nazi old guy with young singer

He's sent a guy over to Schindler The guy sits with Schlinder The older guy comes to get the younger guy He brings the woman over This is a charismatic guy

He sits watching again Gives money

The Germans are talking about the Jews They won't weather this storm

Schindler is leading them in song

9:17

A German in glasses arrives Who is that man Oscar Schindler

GREAT INTRODUCTION OF A CHARACTER

Germans cut Jews hair off 10:21

Schindler walks down the street past the Jews Imposing

The Judenrat 24 elected Jews assign people to jobs (On screen)

If I take this thing off, what will they do They will shoot me

# Step 2: The call to adventure

I am looking for Yitzak Stern Ben Kingsley

12:14

Pots and pans company
He did the books
Can I turn it to making army stuff

He needs money
Where do I get the money
Jewish investors
They can't own the business
Get paid in product

They put up all the money I do the work What do you do The presentation

What's unusual here is that the hero is issuing the call to adventure

14:09

### Step 3 Refusal of the Call

I don't know anybody who would be interested in this Tell them they should be

Again, what's unusual is that it's not the hero that refuses but another character — THE MENTOR figure 14:55

### Step 4 Meeting with the Mentor

In the synagogue Jews barter

Schindler is in there
Nice shirt
Where can I find a nice shirt like that
It's illegal
We don't do that
We're here to pray

How many do you need Schindler

So this scene often is about supernatural intervention They are here in the house of God

All Jews have to be in the ghetto by a certain date

We see them walking in

A Jew collects stuff from his house The Jewish symbol is taken from the door Women says goodbye to her home

Schindler arrives Goodbye Jews Takes over the house Smiles 19:31

Lies in the bed As the Jews who have vacated enter their new "home" Cramped

It could not be better says Schindler

It could be worse - how could it be worse

So this is more ORDINARY WORLD Establishing his character

One of the Jews is working as a policeman He is getting well paid

# Step 5 Crossing the Threshold

Ben Kingsley — Stern
Has arranged a meeting with the owners of the business
Not good enough
Trade goods that is the only currency
Things have changed

He did not call the meeting Forget the whole thing Get out

How can we trust you 22:34

Schindler (for the second time)
Offers a drink and Stern declines

The exchange takes place

# Step 6 Test, Allies & Enemies

Schindler is told the Jews get paid nothing Their salary goes straight to the Germans They get paid less than the Poles That's why he wants to hire Jews

We are establishing our team here He's not hiring Jews because it's humane But because they are cheaper

Jews are being sent away who can't work there

Stern is working to make them Essential workers

If they don't have the Blauschein He teaches history and literature Not essential 25:00

Stern fakes some documentation for him I am a metal polisher

He's saved by Stern

Stern is establishing his credentials as the Mentor figure. Schindler will need to impress this person to win our respect.

26:20

We see how they make this stuff The Professor of History and Literature

Watches on - marvelling really

Don't do this or you will get electrocuted So all these people aren't skilled at this Highly skilled So Stern is working to save these people

Stern is the hero at this point Keeping us interested until the real hero starts acting like one

Schindler auditions typists They aren't doing very well One of them is terrible But he looks captivated

The best is ugly but smokes He has no interest

You have to choose
He lines up with all of these women
He hires all of them
(Except the ugly one probably)

This sequence is often about pulling together teams That's what we're doing here.

29:36

Schindler organises catering for the Nazis Black market trading for fruit, chocolate, champagne, nylon stockings

My pleasure to announce the opening of DEF Schindler reads It's read by Nazi Basket of goods and photo go to all the Nazis

It's now in full operation

The Nazis stamp the orders

Trucks come out of the factories A good doctor A forgiving priest A clever accountant

Once again he toasts
He forces Stern to toast
I'm trying to thank you
I couldn't have done this without you
The usual thing would be to acknowledge
You're welcome

This is saying to us that Schindler has to this point done nothing. Stern doesn't approve of him.

### Step 7 Approach to the Inmost Cave

His wife arrives Girl who has stayed is embarrassed You would like her 33:41

You've done well here You look wonderful Mrs Schindler

So they have an understanding

At dinner
A charade all this
He has 350 on the factory floor
His father had 50
Making money for him
His wife is not impressed
They won't soon forget the name here
Everybody remembers him
He did something extraordinary
He did something no-one else did
He came here with nothing

He has no idea why people will remember him All the riches of the world Nothing has changed, she says There was always something missing It wasn't me You can't create this thing War

We are getting character insight here He's clearly trying to prove something to his father

As he dances with his wife He's looking at another woman

Should I stay?

It's up to you Promise me no-one will assume I'm anyone other than Mrs Schindler and I'll stay

She leaves on a train 37:00

The Approach is often related to love — a little light relief before we tackle the tough stuff.

# Step 8 The Ordeal (the first of many)

He's with Stern Not interested in the figures Has lunch with wine overlooking the factory floor A worker wants to thank him

38:09
A one armed man thanks him
Essential
God bless you
You are a good man
He saved my life
Yes, he did
God bless you
Schindler couldn't give a shit

ORDINARY WORLD again — reminding us that this is not a good  $\operatorname{man}$ .

39:14 Don't do that to me again That man had one arm What's his use Very useful

Important scene to establish character — critical he's still an arsehole.

40:16

Jews are stopped and made to shovel snow

The one armed man is shot

Schindler is upset
I lost a day of production
I lost a worker

The guy challenges Schindler on the metal worker Schindler defends him

Schindler is fucking the girl he saw on the dance floor 42:27

Baldeck It's about Stern

42:42 Schindler goes to the station Stern is on the list

Schindler asks his name
My plant manager is on this train
There is nothing I can do

What is your name I think I can guarantee you'll both be in Russia by the end of the month

Stern Stern Stern

Comedy in the midst of this Finds him Stop the train

Makes no difference to us

Stern had left his card at home What if I had got here 5 mins later Then where would I be? It's still all about him

But is that just a cover This has been a life and death moment

Shoes
Watches
Rings
Diamonds
Teeth pulled from people's mouths
47:12
This has gone to another level — this is deadly

### Step 9 The Reward

When was the last time we stood around and talked The ghetto is liberty
So while they have lost their houses
They are actually coping
But even this is about to be taken from them

Alternatively, this another ORDINARY WORLD phase.

We now re-enter an ORDINARY WORLD phase We are meeting Armon Goeth — Ralph Fiennes Ghetto A — essential workers Ghetto B — surplus

Ralph Fiennes
Is fucking freezing
Doesn't give a shit
Comes to camp
Complains about the house

One of you is a very lucky girl
Which is you has domestic experience
He choose someone who hasn't put up her hand
Helen
51:03
He chooses her

A Jewish Engineer woman says the foundation is wrong Needs to be relaid Shoot her We are not going to have arguments with these people

Take it down
Repour it
Rebuilt it
Like she said

Schindler and Fiennes shave at the same time Here is Schindler's shadow 53:39

For six centuries a Jewish Krakow No more Today is history

Schindler rides a horse with a woman Contrast

The liquidation of the ghetto 55:23

He watches from on high Emphasises that he doesn't need to get involved

THIS IS ANOTHER CALL TO ADVENTURE

The Nazis evacuate and kill

Guy shows Blauschein

They don't care

Baldec's wife says she won't go in the sewers

Stern is almost too slow getting his papers out

Indiscriminate shooting

Poison is being dropped into vials
Given to patients in the hospital
Killing them rather than having to remove them
They smile
They come in and shoot them
Dignified death

1:01:05

Men and Women and children forcibly separated

Jews run down the sewers Baldec just avoids being shot

Comes up a manhole Finds a bunch of dead bodies

Comes up to his house She is gone Down in the streets

A woman takes a child But wont' take the woman Hides in a hole

Baldec says he has been assigned to clear the roads Fiennes laughs

Young boy says to hide under the stairs
He keeps them away
The boy clearly loves the little girl
Come with me I will put you in the good line

Schindler watches and looks troubled AS he watches on

He sees a little girl in a red coat walking down the street 1:06:34

Watches as they shoot a bunch of people

Death of the Jews in Krakow

Little girl in red hides under a bed

They listen with stethoscopes
As the Jews emerge from their hiding places
Guys steps on keys
Firing continues

As one German plays the piano

Fiennes washes his face I wish this fucking night were over

1:10:51 Oscar's factory is silent So this purge has halted his production

Fiennes bare-chested, smoking Looks out over the Jews who have come to his camp

He looks around
And shoots at a woman
Picks his cigarette up with his mouth
Shoots another
Flexes with the rifle behind his shoulders
Points the gun at his lover

Make us a coffee Make it yourself Establishing his character ORDINARY WORLD

1:15:08
CROSSING OF THE THRESHOLD

Schindler comes in to meet everyone Fiennes

Where do you get a suit like that I'd say I'd get you one
But the guy who made it is probably dead
1:16:18

TESTS, ALLIES, ENEMIES
I go to work
Everybody is gone
Nobody tells me
They're not here
They are mine
Every worker who is shot is lost production
It's bad business

Fiennes thanks Lena He clearly likes her He's told that he understands gratitude
You don't want anyone telling you want to do
What you want is your own subcamp
The trouble he would have to go through
I'd be grateful
A deal has been struck

1:19:27
Make sure I get my cut
Fiennes tells Stern
Don't forget who you are working for

This is an APPROACH
Bit of a relax before the harder stuff ahead

Party
Fiennes is drunk and kissing women
Schindler is orchestrating
In control
He gives wine to the guards

Stern comes to Schindler
Gives him the instructions
Who needs to be paid off
Too hard
Too complicated
I couldn't get you out of here
I will be here every Wednesday

Put these in your pockets Herr Direktor, don't let things fall apart

Stern scratches his head so they think he has lice and will keep their distance

Goeth asks guy
What do you make
Hinges
Have workers coming in
Need to make room
Make me a hinge
He does it and he times him
He has made too few hinges
Gun won't fire
Several times
The machines were being recalibrated this morning
Second gun won't fire
Bashes him
But he lives

#### This is ORDINARY WORLD

1:26:12

Schindler brings a saddle out for Fiennes

Stern comes to see him Gives him the lighter With the lighter he bribes his way out to work ihn the factory

Who stole the chicken? Shoots a guy Nobody knows

Boy steps forward Points at the guy he shot

He's very gifted
The boy goes to work for Schindler

1:29:00

Young woman comes to see Schindler at the factory He won't see you

CALL TO ADVENTURE and REFUSAL

She reapplies lip stick Comes in a dress She comes in to see him

CALL TO ADVENTURE
What can I do for you
They say your factory is a haven
They say you are good
Who says that
Everyone
She is Jewish who's been living on false papers
She begs him
Please bring her parents here

**REFUSAL** 

He says he won't do it Cry and I will have you arrested She drops a name

MEETING WITH THE MENTOR - STERN
People die
1:31:52
He's very pissed off
Think you don't know what I'm doing
It's dangerous to me
You have to understand

War brings out the worst in people Always the bad, never the good He's about to make a lie of that

Tells a story that Goeth killed 25 people

Perlman
He has done what the woman asked
Despite his protests
And gives up his watch to secure their services

HE HAS CROSSED THE THRESHOLD

TURNING POINT IN HIS JOURNEY

TESTS, ALLIES, ENEMIES

#### **PARTY**

1:39:34

1:35:17 Schindler comes down to cellar Talks to Helen I am Schindler He gives her something — chocolate?

She says the first day
He beat me for throwing away bones for his dogs
Why are you beating me
I know your sufferings
One day he'll shoot me
She says that he shot someone just passing

There are no set rules you can live by He won't shoot you because he enjoys you Won't let her wear the star He kisses her on the forehead

Where does this fit in? It's a bit like a sharing of the elixir

A wonderful party
You're not a drunk
You have control
Talk about power and justice
Power is when we have every justification to kill and we choose not
The emperor pardons him
This worthless man

He's trying to influence Goeth That is power

SHARING OF THE ELIXIR — OR IT COULD A CALL TO ADVENTURE FOR GOETH — which he pursues briefly. The Shadow fails to respond.

1:41:55

Nazi people going over Stern's books

Stable boy dropped the saddle
He would have killed him in the past
Stern's reaction indicates that he has changed

He rides on a horse

Jews communicating with one another He rides past on his horse

She was smoking on the job Tell her not to do it again This is all Schindler's work

Have been unable to remove stains
Using soap not lye
Go on leave
I pardon you
Looks at himself in the mirror
He is the emperor

Does he find some dirt on the mirror?

1:44:45
He fires a shot at him
Kills him

So he's still a cunt

Helen does his nails He's clearly attracted

A couple are married in the camp 1:46:43

He comes down while she is washing
If you need a reference after the war
Must get lonely down here
Sometimes we're both lonely
I want to reach out and touch you
What would be wrong with that
I realise you're not a person in the strictest sense

1:49:15
When they compare you to vermin

He touches her As the singer kisses Schindler

No, I don't' think so You're a jewish bitch You nearly talked me into it, didn't' you He beats her

Goeth has refused the call.

1:51:26

He is wished a happy birthday by the workers He kisses a jewish girl Trouble

THIS IS A ROAD HOME scene

A Jewish girl tells a story of a concentration camp Gassed them They cannot believe it It doesn't make any sense What sense does it make to kill your workforce It can't be true We are very very important for them

1:53:50 Train carriages arrive Doctors come out

He has to make room Another shipment coming in They strip off

The woman prick their fingers
So they can put blood on their cheeks
Give themselves some colour

Goeth saves one woman Separate the sick from the healthy

A huge group of children comes out 1:58:38

Some of them run away

The smart little kid makes a run for it

The kids are piled onto trucks and drive away Waving

Elation at having survived the cull

Turns to horror as their children are taken away 2:00:54

Kid tries to find a hiding place They are all taken He climbs down into a latrine Get out This is our place

(Amazing scene)

This is a Resurrection scene

People piled onto trains Why didn't you call me Quite a picnic 2:02:55

Another beautiful day Hot People suffocating on board the train

What do you say we get the firehoses out and hose down the cars
Where's the fire?
He laughs
But then gets up and does it
More
More

This is cruel Oscar You are giving them hope

He says he has longer hoses They all laugh But he gets them and hoses the last carriages

They laugh at him But he does it

He has water to give them when the train stops

ORDEAL

An SS car pulls up at the DEF factory

2:05:27

They take him away

He's in a cell I kissed a Jewish girl Did your prick fall off He just goes along with the joke

Goeth defends him
He likes women
He sees a beautiful woman, he doesn't think
He shouldn't have done it
They cast a spell on you, the jews
It's like typhus

A senior Nazi figure comes in It's policy now

That's the end of disk one

Goeth ordered to exhume and incinerate all the Jews 1:57

The party is over Oscar
They are sending them all to Auschwitz

ROAD HOME

We see the body of the little girl in the red coat go past — a muddied body Oscar alarmed

2:39

He's put in a special word for Stern
You'll get preferential treatment
You ran my business
I am going home
I have more money than I could spend
Some day this is all going to end
I was ggoing to say we'll have a drink then
I think I better have it now
He always refused in the past

This is the road home

THE RESURRECTION

A naked woman sleeps in Schindler's bed

His bags are packed His home is packed He has trunks full of money

He wants his people He's going to take his people to Czechoslavakia He is going to make artillery shells He can't work out how he's going to make money out of it 7:17
He starts making his list
All the children

How many More

We keep hearing the typewriter

Goeth opens his trunk full of money

8:33

How many 600

More

He approaches another man Tries to get him to do it He says he won't accept that

How many 850

that's it You can finish that page

What did Goeth say
You're not buying them
You're buying them?
You're paying for them
Finish the page
Leave one space at the bottom

The list is an absolute good Life all around

He wants to take Helen
Play a game of 21 for Helen
He says he wants to take her to Vienna with him
He can't
He says he should take her into the woods and shoot her
painlessly in the back of the head

He agrees to play a game for her

Then we see the people on the list Including the little kid

Stern

Helen is there - the last we see

THE REWARD

They all pile onto trains Guided by Stern

They arrive in Schlinder's home town in Czechoslavakia 15:45
He is there to meet them

Schlinder addresses them

The women's train will arrive shortly Only a short walk to the factory

Welcome

THE ORDEAL

The women talk about good things

A kid makes the sign of a slit throat

The train arrives in a concentration camp Auschwitz

18:15

They are taken off Freezing cold Where are the list makers

They are being showered with ash from a huge furnace

20:07

Schindler is not happy Their train was routed to the wrong place Paper work slip up

Their hair is clipped

They strip off
They head into showers
WE look in through a porthole
Lights go out

Water starts coming out of the shower heads Is this a false dawn? There is some relief Will the gas follow?

No.

The women are lined up outside the barracks The older women are being singled out We are Schindler's jews

#### THE RESURRECTION

A Nazi looks at Schlinder's List
He says it's not his job to interfere
Why should I interfere
He lays out a whole lot of jewels
I could have you arrested
I am protected by powerful friends
He takes them
26:30

He says he'll give him 300 units Fresh units He doesn't want them He wants his List You shouldn't get stuck on names

THIS IS A BIG SCENES

But the list is actioned 27:30

So we've been through an ordeal

This is a resurrection These people were dead

A guard tries to take someone away

28:35

They protest
Schlinder interferes
These are my people
Their fingers polish the inside of a 45mm shell casing
Back on the train
Back on the train

The train leaves 29:38

We watch as Schindler guides his flock into his Czech factory

The men watch and wait

He makes it clear that they can't shoot indiscriminately No summary executions
No interference with production
Guards no longer allowed on the factory floor
For your co-operation you have my gratitude
He serves them beer
Nazi doesn't look happy about it

32:32

He comes up behind his wife He makes a promise to his wife

He introduces Stern to his wife This is my wife No secrets

We have received complaints from the armaments
They are withholding payment
Rumour you have been recalibrating the machines
They could send us back
Ask around
Find out where we can buy shells
If this factory ever makes a shell that can be fired I'll
be very unhappy

Rabbi
The sun is going down
What day is this
Friday
You should be preparing for the Sabbath shouldn't you
I've got some wine

35:07
A candle is lit
Where are back where we came in
We have come in full circle

SHOULD SHOW THESE TWO SCENES

The ceremony proceeds
The Germans are not happy

Schindler runs out of money Why
Am I broke?
36:37

Churchill announces the surrender The German was is at an end

Schlinder announces it to the factory

Tomorrow you'll begin looking for your families
In most cases you won't find them
We've survived
Many of you have thanked me
Thank yourselves
Thank your fearless Stern
I am a member of the Nazi party
A munitions manufacturer
A black market profiteer
I will be hunted
I will have to flee

You have received orders to exterminate these people Or you could leave and return to your families as men, instead of murderers. And they leave

39:45

The head Nazi guy leaves Schlinder winks at Stern

IN memory of the countless victims
I ask us to observe 3 minutes of silence

We linger on people we've met

They take out a filling from a guy's tooth They pour it into a ring

Schlinder packs

He wants cloth distributed to his workers Vodka Cigarettes

WE have written a letter in case you are captured Every worker has signed it Stern gives him a ring It's from Hebrew It says whoever saves one life save the world entire

They shake hands
I could have got more out
I could have got more
There are 1000 people
If I'd made more oney
I threw away so much money
I didn't do enough
This car
Why did I keep the car
10 people right there
2 more people

At least one more One more person He breaks down They hug him

HAVE TO SHOW THIS SCENE

He dresses in prison attire And drives out

All these people are alive because of him

SHARING OF THE ELIXIR

47:25

You have been liberated by the Soviet Army Stern speaks to him Have you been in Poland? Are there any Jews left? Where should we go? Not East nor West We could use some food

They move as one across the fields

Goeth is hanged

Schindler failed at his marriage and several businesses

In 1958 declared a righteous person Invited to plant a tree It grows there still

We swtich to colour

Families come and lay stones on his grave

Sharing of the Elixir
They are there with their families

His wife is there

Thousands of people are there

Fewer than 4000 Jews in Poland More than 6000 descendants of Schindler jews A rose is laid
