ORDINARY WORLD

A knocking on the door — no answer MILES (Paul Giamatta) has to move his car

Saturday San Diego, CA

He has to move his car for workman Not sure what that tells us about him

He's really late Calls his friend Says he's out the door — but he's not and his place is a mess

Then stops to get himself a spinach croissant Clearly a foodee

Does the crossword on the steering wheel as he drives Clearly bright, verbal

3:07

He stops to pick up his mate, JACK (Thomas Hayden Church) Big house in Los Angeles He's very late

Meet the fiancée, CHRISTINE Very beautiful

Asks Miles opinion on the cake (though noone actually says wedding)

They congratulate him for his novel getting published But it doesn't look it's over the line

He prefers the dark cake Like his character

5:39

They drive off - the ADVENTURE is underway

Where the fuck were you, man? Says the traffic was bad But Jack says you're hungover

They clear up the book deal Miles is not confident it will happen But his friend says he thinks it will Glass half full/half empty They are spending a week together Jack opens the bottle against his wishes Pinot noir Miles gives him an explanation

Asks him his impression of the new draft of the book Lies — hasn't read it

9:19

Stop in to see Miles' mother

Jack not happy

But then says it's for his mother's birthday

Comes out that Jack is getting married next week Mentions his starring role as Derek Somersby Clearly Jack was a minor celebrity

They stay for dinner 11:47

Mother says his sister Wendy is coming over in the morning
Not keen to stay
Clearly not a tight family

Slips away and steals money 12:50

Clearly he's short of money — and morals

Picture of him with wife on her dresser Melancholic when he returns

Miles is Jack's best man
Mother says that Miles should get back with his former
wife, Victoria
He says he just got divorced
Two years ago, buddy
She was good for you
His mother worries about him

He is a man in pain

Sunday 14:43

Jack is coming on to a young waitress

CALL TO ADVENTURE — beyond just their week together Jack says that he's going to get Miles laid

That will be his present to him

REFUSAL

Miles isn't keen - I'd rather have a knife

Miles is on anti-depressants Seeing a shrink

Fuck therapy

You need to get your joint worked on, Miles Miles says he's going to show Jack a good time And Jack says "And get your bone smooched"

Jack is a MENTOR figure - however flawed

17:40

In the car, Miles gives Jack a wine education Pinot is a thin skinned grape (Just like him)

They visit their first winery Miles, the wine MENTOR, teaches Jack He knows his shit

Jack woofs it down
Miles takes his time — too busy analysing
Too in his head.

They stop at the Windmill Inn 20:40

MEETING WITH THE MENTOR

Jack asks if he's making a mistake getting married to Christine

With his experience

Christine's father is asking him to join the father's business

But it wouldn't mean giving up acting (Yeah, right)

Come into the restaurant — the classic WATERING HOLE scene

They ask him how his book is going

22:54

They toast to us
It's going to be great
FORESHADOWING that it isn't going to be

Waitress in the restaurant

Who's that chick?
CALL TO ADVENTURE - ALLY
Maya (Virginia Madsden)
Jack says that she's cute
Miles says she's married - REFUSAL

She comes over
She's obviously into you, Miles
Into wine
Likes Pinot
A waitress here?
How is that ever going to work out?
Why do you have to always see the negative? Jack asks
Miles

25:06
Maya finishes work
Miles, uncharacteristically, invites her over

This is a CROSSING OF THE FIRST THRESHOLD for Miles

She asks how the book is going
Jack says it's being published
That's why they are celebrating
(Clearly he's not going to let on that he's getting
married)

She asks him what they're doing tonight Miles says that they're tired and going home REFUSAL Jack is pissed off Miles 27:18

She's not married No rock

Monday

MEETING WITH THE MENTOR
They have breakfast
Jack says he's not going to let Miles fuck up his week
He's going to get laid
Again, a CALL TO ADVENTURE

Miles hands over his keys in a fit of pique REFUSAL

Jack says it's their week to cut loose It's something they should share 29:55

CROSSING THE THRESHOLD

They do a wine tour Several vineyards

Jack is into quantity Fuck the quality

CALL TO ADVENTURE - ALLY
They meet Stephanie (Sandra Oh)
31:00

Jack keen — not very big on REFUSAL where women are concerned
Miles is critical of the wine
Cabernet Franc
Jack says where they are staying

Jack is making conversation
Find out she knows Maya
Miles is blind to the opportunity
Impatient to taste more wine
Further indication of his character flaw

Jack says Stephanie's a bad girl She says she needs to be spanked

When Jack emerges he has it all organised They are all going out Jack, Miles, Stephanie, Maya

Jack is pissed off that Miles almost told Stephanie that he's getting married

33:35

ORDEAL

They stop at a place where he shared a wine with his ex wife, Victoria
Jack has something to tell him
Victoria is coming to the wedding
He knew that
And she got remarried
About 6 weeks ago
A guy with a restaurant
(ie A successful version of Miles)

Miles wants to be driven home

He's not happy that jack has been talking about the situation of Miles at the wedding with Victoria

Grabs a bottle of wine Swigs it

Runs off into the vineyard

This is the death of his marriage He had been kidding himself Still living in that place Now he has to admit it's gone

REWARD

They lie on the bed back at the motel

Jack goes down for a swim Miles stays Is asleep when Jack returns

Miles is talking about some girl down at the Jacuzzi He's going nuts

APPROACH

Jack tries to help Miles choose his clothes Calls his fiancée

Jack says he's not going to accept Miles fucking up his night

If they want to drink Merlot, we're drinking Merlot

If they want to drink Merlot, we're drinking Merlot Miles nearly freaks We're not drinking Merlot!!!

They come in and join the ladies for dinner Miles and Maya talk wine Jack and Stephanie talk shit

41:38

Montage of dinner

Jack says they are there to celebrate Miles' book deal

They are overdoing the montage a bit

Miles is getting a bit drink and a bit boringly technical He's not really in the moment

Jack looks worried Tries to stop Miles drinking Maya sees he's drinking too much

Miles calls Victoria 43:31

ORDEAL

She can tell he's pissed She says don't call her when he's drunk Says he's decided not to go to the wedding
He was taken aback
Thought maybe there was a chance
She says maybe it would be good if he didn't come to the wedding

Slumps back in his chair at the restaurant Pissed
Depressed

MEETING WITH THE MENTOR

Maya and Stephanie excuse themselves

What the fuck!!! Get your shit together!!! Says jack

Did you drink and dial?

Jack says Maya is great

Says he can't keep doing this downer bullshit

Miles points out that life wasn't always so great with

Victoria. Made him feel small.

Miles doesn't want to hear it.

But after the pep talk, he's pers up a bit

The girls have decided they should retire to their place

As Jack and Miles go in, Jack gives Miles a condom and keeps several for himself

REWARD

Miles joins Maya out back Stephanie has retired with Jack to the bedroom

Miles is in a better place now He says he has a '61 Cheval Blanc just sitting at home What are you waiting for?

He says he's waiting for a special occasion

CALL TO ADVENTURE

She says the day you open a '61 Cheval Blanc, that's the special occasion

He acknowledges that Maya's assessment of the wine they are drinking is right.

Stephanie has a kid Miles doesn't have any

51:07

We can hear Jack doing his schtick

Maya and Miles head outside
She asks about his novel
The Day after Yesterday
You mean today?
It sums him up — he's not in the now
And it sounds like a complete crock of shit
52:35

She's writing a paper Doing a Masters in Horticulture She commutes to attend college Plans to work in a winery

She wants to read his book Says he happens to have a manuscript in his car

Then we hear Jack and Stephanie fucking 53:40
They don't know where to look
Need to move so they can't hear it

She asks a personal question
Why are you so into Pinot?
He says it's a hard grape to grow
Temperamental
Not a survivor
Pinot needs constant care and attention
Only grows in tiny tucked away corners
Only responds to the most patient and nurturing of
growers
He is describing what is needed of the person who is
going to bring the best out in him

Why is she into wine?
Got into it through her ex husband
Discovered she had a sharp palate
She likes to think about the life of wine
How it's a living thing
What was happening when the wine was growing
The people who tended and picked the grapes
Likes the way it continues to evolve
Very lyrical description

And it tastes so fucking good

She has her hand on his Clearly up for it — CALL TO ADVENTURE

But he declines REFUSAL

Changes the subject

He's scared
Been hurt — doesn't want to go there again

In the bathroom
Looks at himself
You're such a fucking loser
He is literally looking at himself in the mirror — it's
the halfway point of the film. Very typical for this to
happen at this point — at least in a figurative sense.

He comes into the kitchen Kisses Maya She says she should go 58:40

He follows her in his car

Then she gets out of the car Gives him directions to the Windmill Says she had a great time tonight Still want to read novel? He hands over the manuscript Two boxes worth

The two cars diverge

Tuesday
Jack's mobile phone is ringing
It's his fiancée calling
Then she calls on the motel phone
1:00:45

Jack returns
Sound of motorbike
That chick is unbelievable
Stephanie is down on her motorbike
He wants to go with her for a hike
Rather than play golf with Miles

MEETING WITH THE MENTOR

Jack says Miles was a dumb fuck last night
Miles says he should call Christine
Miles goes outside while he makes the call
Steph says Maya had a fun time
You should call her - CALL

Jack wants the condom he gave Jack earlier

They drive off
Miles looks self-pitying

1:03:57

APPROACH
Cuts his toenails
Comes down for crap breakfast
Rubbish coffee
Makes notes on his manuscript

No messages on his phone Eats lunch alone

Plays golf alone No joy

Returns to the room to find Jack fucking Stephanie Has to leave the room

1:05:31 Miles joins Jack in the bar Stephanie took Jack to the Pinot fields Says he's getting into it

MEETING WITH THE MENTOR
Miles asks Jack what he's doing with this girl
Says he's been honest
Hasn't said he's available
He's been thinking about putting the wedding on hold
He says being with Stephanie has opened his eyes
Miles points out that Jack is being an idiot
Jack says they should move up here and run a vineyard
together
Miles says he's crazy

They go to an amusement arcade Jack plays with Stephanie's kid, Sienna Stephanie's mother (?) bitching Jack goes off with them all Leaving Miles on his own again 1:09:22

Miles buys some supplies Including a Barely Legal porn magazine Pulls the blinds

Falls asleep with the Barely Legal on his chest

1:10:13
Wakes up with fresh resolve
Goes to the Hitching Post

But Maya isn't working that night Finds this out after he's ordered a bottle of wine

Owner a bit worried about Miles Very pissed as he leaves 1:11:41

This sequence didn't advance the story a whole lot

Wednesday Jacks tees off at golf Says Maya really likes Miles

Miles hasn't heard anything from his agent No messages Jack thinks his negativity is premature Says he should publish himself

APPROACH

Miles tells him to shut up Where is this hostility coming from?

Some guy hits through them
So Miles turns around and hits back at them
1:14:46

They come at them with buggies Jack chases them with a club

Jack says Miles has to persist with Maya Says that when she finds out he's not published If a guy doesn't have money at this age ... Negative, negative, negative 1:16:32

REWARD

Stephanie calls
They hook up with the girls
Maya says she's glad he stopped by at the restaurant
He plays it down
But clearly she is keen

They stop for a wine lecture Pompous lecture by a Pom

They retire
Head into where the vats are

1:18:23

They picnic in the fields

Again, a lot of montage

Back at Stephanie's place

They are partying Sienna, the daughter comes out Uncle Jack will put you back to bed

1:19:14
Maya drives Miles home
Miles looks happy
They retire to her place
He puts his hand on her shoulder
They kiss
She drags him inside

Thursday Maya wakes Looks at Miles in bed

More montage
Maya and Miles at some sort of fair

THE ROAD HOME
They picnic
She mentions a dinner on Sat night
Miles say they have to get back for the rehearsal dinner
Who's getting married?

She's really pissed off Jack has been spinning quite a story to Stephanie

So, just when it was going well, it fucks up.
She says her relationship was full of deception
She's just tried to get herself out of that
He says it's been a big deal for him
He says he's not Jack
He's his freshman year room-mate from San Diego State
(An example of how you don't have to dump this stuff out early)

When he gets back
Jack hugs him
So happy for him
Jack wants details
But Miles won't play ball

Miles says Jack is an infant

Christine calls He answers

Miles curls up in a ball
The week hasn't gone the way he hoped
Miles says he knows the solution

Takes him to a big touristy vineyard Wine filling trucks
Guys on guitar
Bus loads of people

Miles thinks the wine is absolute shit

ORDEAL

He calls his agent 1:27:42

The publisher is passing
They liked it
Didn't know how to market it
She doesn't think she can take it any further

He comes back in
He gets a taste
Throws it back
Asks for a refill
Throws it back
Tells him it's a winery not a bar
He suggests he should buy a bottle and go outside
They fight over a glass
He pours the dregs bucket over himself

GREAT SCENE

REWARD

Miles sits with Jack Says he can't write another book Doesn't matter what he has to say

1:31:44

Half his life is over and he has nothing to show for it

ORDEAL

They head back Stephanie is waiting

Punches the fuck out of Jack Breaks his nose with her bike helmet You said you loved me

Miles won't even admit to having told Maya

They wait in a doctor's surgery

REWARD

Miles calls Maya Says how much he enjoyed their time together His book not getting published Not much of a writer Not much of anything

Montage again

Jack comes out looking the worse for wear Needs a couple of operations
Might fuck up his career
But he won't sue — to protect Christine

1:36:19

Miles still won't admit that he told Maya

REWARD

They go out for dinner
Jack hits on the chubby waitress
She recognises him from his TV series
Derek Somersby from One Life to Live
She is thrilled

Jack is going to head off with Cammy Miles can't believe it 1:39:11

Can't we just go home?

Jack says there are things he has to do that Miles doesn't understand.

Demonstrates Jack's indomitable spirit

Friday

Mad beating on the door

Jack comes in naked Freezing Needs pain relievers

Chick was married Husband comes home and catches him with cock in his wife's ass Ran home Through an ostrich farm

REWARD

Miles pisses himself laughing

THE ROAD HOME
He has to go back there
The rings are in the wallet

CALL TO ADVENTURE They have to go back

REFUSAL

Miles says just say you left them in the bar

CROSSING THE THRESHOLD

Jack breaks down and Miles agrees

RESURRECTION
They drive back there
The plan?
Jack wants Miles to go
His ankle is buggered

Miles goes in Showing a bit of spine

Can't find the wallet in Jacks' jeans

Crawls along the floor They are fucking As they relive what she did

Sees the wallet on the dresser Goes into the room

Grabs the wallet

Gets chased out by fat hairy naked guy

They drive off

This is probably something that Miles wouldn't have done earlier.

REWARD

Miles packs up

They drive off home

Jack says Miles should invite Maya to the wedding

Jack wants to drive
Veers off the road
1:46:10
Drives the car into a tree
Miles not happy
Jack not happy either
Doesn't look severe enough — to be the cause of his broken nose

Tries to line it up to hit a tree But it misses Goes through a fence And ends in a ditch

1:48:19

Drops off Jack at his house Can't leave until they see the car Christine and family buy the story Miles looks unhappy

Saturday 1:49:32 Armenian wedding

RESURRECTION for Jack Rings go on Miles is there Jack has to apply the cross Smiles as he does so

SHARING OF THE ELIXIR

Outside the wedding Miles watches
Victoria is there
1:51:10
Meets the new husband
She asks after the book
Admits it's dead
Let's got to the reception — drink a few champagnes

ORDEAL

Not drinking — she's pregnant A knife in the stomach Miles leaves While everyone else heads right out of the church car park He heads left

1:55:11

Goes back to his place
Gets the bottle of 61 Cheval Blanc
Eats a burger
Splashes this beautiful wine into a plastic cup
He's following Maya's advice — to not wait

He's teaching English
Student is reading about a funeral

Comes home to his apartment
One new message
Maya
Thanks for your letter — we didn't know about this
Would have called sooner ...
Wanted to read your book

Beautiful
She was confused by the ending
Did the father commit suicide or not?

Says she mightn't be at the restaurant much longer About to graduate

He knocks on her door. 1:59:45

SUMMARY

I love this film. Two fantastic characters, perfectly contrasted, with a very simple story setup. Even though it's not high concept, there is still an over-arching narrative - Jack is going to get married in a week - and that both generates drama and creates a narrative destination. There are some fabulous scenes here - "We're not drinking Merlot!!!", drinking the wine dregs, crawling in to retrieve the wallet, the car missing the tree — but there is a little too much montage which dissipates some of the dramatic tension. There are several ordeals here - Miles finding out Victoria has remarried, calling Victoria (drunk and dial), that his book has been rejected, that Victoria is pregnant, and Jack has a spectacular ordeal with Stephanie where his nose comes off second best - that confront the characters and push them to extend themselves. The one major disappointment is probably the ending. Some will like the minimalism, but I like to be moved by the drama and I'm not moved by this ending. A lot of it is a phone message on an answering machine - hardly cinematic. Yes, he's mov ed to a better place, but I like more emotional punch and they've pulled theirs. Still, a lovely film that still made me laugh at the second watching.
